**Admission Guidelines for the admission in Ph.D. (Sanskrit), University of Delhi, Delhi for the academic session 2022-23**

**1. Admission Process under Non-NET category-**

- i. The candidate be examined based on 100 marks in the NON-NET Category of admission. It includes 70 marks for the academic scores (B.A., M.A., M.Phil., NET/Entrance Test Marks) and 30 marks for the interview. The distribution of the marks is listed below:

**2. Admission Process under JRF or Any other Fellowship as mentioned in Research Ordinance of the University-**

- i. The candidate be examined based on 100 marks in JRF and other Fellowship Categories of admission. It includes 70 marks for the academic scores (B.A., M.A., M.Phil. and Entrance Test Marks / NET) and 30 for the interview. The distribution of the marks is listed below:

- ii. **The total percentage of the passing marks in the above will be 55% for the general category and for reserved categories the Relaxation will be given as per the rules.**
- iii. The interview should consider the competence of the proposed research area/discipline and proposed research can contribute new/additional knowledge in the field. After getting admission DRC will allocate a tentative Research Advisory Board for each student and the tentative title for the research will be proposed after completion of the coursework within one year. *(As per University Research Ordinance Amendments dated August 09, 2017, Page No. 09, Point No 15)* **(This clause should be implemented after approval from the Research Council, University of Delhi)**  
In case of **Research Council, University of Delhi** doesn't approve this recommendation then the interview should be considered the proposed title of the research and the name with the title of the and name of the Research Advisory Board should be communicated to the BRS as per past practices.
- iv. All candidates should submit a brief write-up of the area of the interest/research proposal on prescribed proforma by the department with the Application form Number on the first paper. Candidate should ensure that his/her name and other information should not written anywhere on the proforma other than the Application form Number.  
All the admission process will be transparent and the result will be published with the Application number only.

**Total Seats in PhD (Sanskrit)-**

The total seat for admission in Ph.D. (Sanskrit) will be as per rules under NON-NET Category and the Total vacant seats available under the departmental faculty members and a few seats may be allotted to the College teachers by the DRC for the academic session 202-23.
